

Tour in Xi'an

A Natural Museum of History & Start Point of "Silk Road".

There are 544 key units of cultural relic under protection and more than 5700 sites within the city.

With a history of more than 3100 years, Xi'an is one of the four Great Ancient Capital Cities together with Athens, Rome and Cairo. From the 11th century BC to the 10th century A.D, there were a total of about 13 dynasties or regimes which made Xi'an their capital.

Terracotta Army

It is around 1.5 kilometers east of Emperor Qin Shi Huang's Mausoleum. As the most significant sight in China, it's not to be missed.



Qin ShiHuang's Mausoleum

As the first huge ancient mausoleum in China, it displays the skill and craftsman-ship of the country's tomb construction.



Huaqing Pool

It is well known for the romantic love story between Emperor Xuanzong and his favorite concubine, Yang Yuhuan, in the Tang Dynasty.



Shanxi Museum

As the first large scale national museum in China, it displays the history of Shanxi Province and the ancient Chinese civilization.



Bell Tower

Marking the geographical center of the ancient capital, it is the largest and best-preserved of its kind in China. Standing on a square base 36 meters high, the tower connects the four gates of the City Wall through four streets extending in each direction.



Dayan Pagoda

It is one of the most famous Buddhist pagodas in China and has been regarded as the symbol of Xi' an. You can climb up to the top of the pagoda through the wooden stairs to appreciate the panoramic view of the ancient city in distance.



Tang Dynasty Music and Dance Show

This performance is one of the most attractive entertainment activities for tourists to Xi' an. They take roots from the historical records and folk legends about the Tang Dynasty and show to the audience the life and social costumes of those times through instrument playing and dancing.
