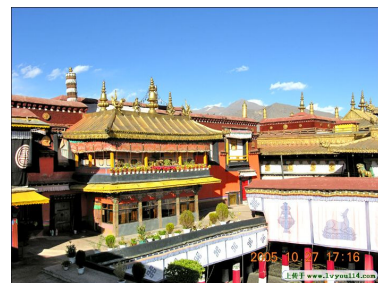


Drepung Monastery
